3.	Bid proposals are to be submitted at MISA Head Office in Centurion (Tender Box at the reception area). The physical address is as follows: 1303 Heuwel Avenue, Riverside Office Park, Letaba House 1 st Floor, Centurion, 0046.
4.	Standard Bidding Documents (SBD1, SBD 4, and SBD 6.1) and all returnable documents must be fully completed, where something does not apply to your company indicate by "N/A"; and sign where spaces are provided.
5.	Bidders are to submit two (2) hard copies (the original document and a copy of the original) of the tender document, and 1 soft copy (memory stick) of the tender document.

6.	The appointed service provider will render the service in Kannaland Local Municipality.
7.	One Bidder will be awarded the bid to render the required services.
8.	SCM presented the compliance and administrative of the bid document to the bidders in attendance. No question was asked based on the presentation.
9.	The end-user presented the scope of work with the BOQ. The end-user stated that the appointed bidder will do the delivery and installation of the RMUs as it is catered for in the BOQ.
